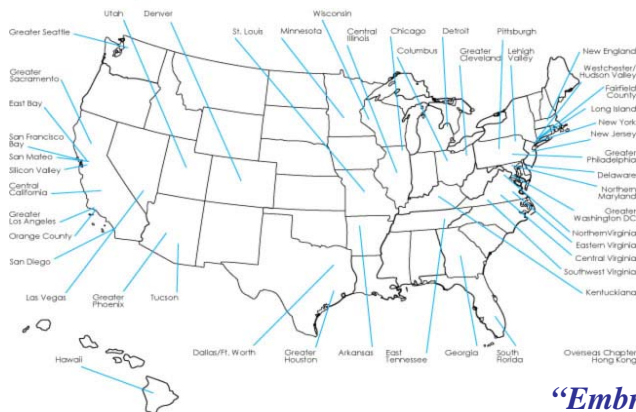
OCA's primary objectives include:
